YARD DUTY AND SUPERVISION POLICY

Vermont South Special School understands it holds a high standard of care in relation to students at school. Appropriate, well-organised and responsive supervision of students during class time, recess and lunch is an important aspect of keeping students safe at school. It also enables staff to identify and respond to possible risks at school as they arise.

Staff participate in Vermont South Special School's yard duty roster and school supervision requirements, and follow clear procedures for responding to accidents or incidents in the playground and learning areas.

School staff are rostered on for yard duty before school (meeting buses and also in playground areas), during recess, lunch and for afternoon bus line at the end of the school day. School grounds are supervised before school from 8:40am.

Vermont South Special School has in place a number of internal policies and procedures in place to respond to specific circumstances and potential risks in schools, including:

- Camps and excursions
- First Aid
- Student private property.

School staff, parents and students are encouraged to speak to our principal if you have any concerns about potential risks at our school, or our duty of care obligations.
